

Dog exclusion zones - Wellow Play Park -

Dog exclusion zones are areas where dogs are not allowed. They include all fenced-in children's play areas and also apply to some other green spaces.

This is a gentle reminder to residents that the Dog Exclusion order in the Play Park is still in force - it was created over 35 years ago and is for the safety of the public especially children using the area.

Additional signage will shortly be erected to make this clear from all sides of the park. Please also be aware that Newark and Sherwood District Council take this matter seriously and their Dog Wardens will be monitoring the area.

What is a dog exclusion zone?

It is an offence to allow your dog to enter a designated Dog Exclusion area. Failure to comply with the Dogs Exclusion Order 2012, can result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued.

What happens if I don't comply with the dogs exclusion order 2012?

Failure to comply with the Dogs Exclusion Order 2012, can result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued.
